

PARLIAMENTARY BUREAU: APPROVAL OF SCOTTISH STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

MADE AFFIRMATIVE INSTRUMENTS

[Health Protection \(Coronavirus\) \(Requirements\) \(Scotland\) Amendment \(No. 6\) Regulations 2022 \(SSI 2022/123\)](#)

1. Under Rule 10.6.5, the Bureau is required to lodge the following motion—

George Adam on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau: That the Parliament agrees that the Health Protection (Coronavirus) (Requirements) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 6) Regulations 2022 (SSI 2022/123) be approved.

Purpose

2. To remove the requirement for a person who enters or remains indoors within a place of worship to wear a face covering. They also remove requirements to wear face coverings at marriage ceremonies, civil partnership registrations, funerals and commemorative events related to the end of a person's life.

Consideration by committee

3. At its meeting on 28 April 2022, the COVID-19 Recovery Committee agreed to recommend that the regulations be approved. The Committee report will be published on 28 April 2022.

Decision
