5 In regulation 44 of the Conservation (Natural Habitats, etc.) Regulations 1994 (SI 1994/2716), after paragraph (2) insert—

10 “(2ZA) The Scottish Ministers may not grant a licence under paragraph (2) in relation to the beaver (Eurasian or European) unless they are satisfied that, at the time of the licence application, the population of beavers (Eurasian or European) in Scotland is at a favourable conservation status (within the meaning given by paragraph (i) of Article 1 of Council Directive 92/43/EEC on the conservation of natural habitats and of wild fauna and flora).”.>
